


Career Interest Development: Level One

- Use creativity to connect elements of self to an image of professional self-representation.
- Generate ideas.



ELEMENTS OF DESIGN: WHAT DO THEY SAY ABOUT YOU?

ACTIVITY

- Students will sketch a design of their room during a professional video conferencing session (i.e., Zoom).
- Present scenario

SCENARIO

- Instructor will play the role of the employer in the following scenario and will describe the business (e.g., an architectural design firm).
- The students are recently hired.
- Due to social distancing, employees will be asked to telecommute and design an appropriate workspace at home, based on their current living space.
- The employer offers a "reasonable" budget, standard electronics (i.e., computer with camera, printer/scanner), and a desk.

CONSIDERATIONS

- elements: color, balance, contrast, line, symmetry, shape, repetition and rhythm
- wall material, paint, or wall covering
- accessories, such as shelving, artwork, furniture, flooring, windows
- lighting

EXTENSION IDEAS

- If you like the nucleus of this idea, consider expanding it for a larger project.

 Students may create a design board, with related costs, and an idea of budget.
 This also introduces them to at least one student organization which are very important to career skills development.
- Have students create an emergency management plan for the school/classroom, due to weather events or fire. Planning is a great way to manage stress over these types of emergencies, but planning might be a good way to manage stress about any future event.
